Identity Theft

Identity theft happens when someone uses your personal or financial information without your permission.

Scams

A scam is a dishonest or fraudulent scheme that attempts to take money or something of value from people.

5 STEPS TO PREVENT FRAUD

- 1. Don't answer phone calls or open emails from someone you don't know.
- 2. Protect your personal information.
- 3. Please take a look at your Credit Report often.
- 4. Set high privacy settings on social media accounts.
- 5. Don't use public Wi-Fi.
